Thank you for participating in our Charity Show.

We have attached a mud map of the school grounds for you. It is near the Chapel.

Please arrive at **3.00pm** so we can rehearse the children on the stage and dress them in costumes. Your child will then perform in the 4.00pm Show.

Princess Jasmine cannot have individual photos but after your group has performed, we will put the house lights up for 5 minutes allowing you to take a group shot. (She may walk around the foyer after the show, so keep an eye out)

Please send your children with their hair in a neat bun (for girls). Children **do not** need to wear their ballet leotard. Come in Paul Wright shoes and tights. These are available from the office shop and will also be used in class and the end of year concert. Please dress your child in clothing that will not mess their hair or makeup. Our volunteer parents will dress the children in the costume supplied by Sayers.

We suggest basic make up as we will have professional stage lighting. Make up should consist of light foundation, blush, and brown eye shadow and stay on smudge free lipstick. PLEASE DO NOT SEND MAKE UP IN YOUR CHILD'S BAG ...YOU CAN IMAGINE THE FUN THEY WILL HAVE WITH THAT!!!

At the end of the show, we will bring children onto the stage for parents to collect.
