<u>COLOURED JAZZ: -</u> Fun funky dance class, only current classical students may attend these class as their Ballet training gives the strength and technique to progress quickly. It is an option to perform in the charity concert and end of year concert with this class.

<u>CONTEMPORARY - GR 2 UP: -</u> Contemporary dance is a style of expressive dance that combines elements of several dance genres including modern, jazz, lyrical and classical ballet. Contemporary dancers strive to connect the mind and the body through fluid dance movements. It is an option to perform in the charity concert and end of year concert with this class.
